The Regional Youth Information Centre of Nouvelle-Aquitaine (Centre Régional Information Jeunesse Nouvelle-Aquitaine, in French) is looking for **one Spanish volunteer or legally residing in Spain (coming from the Canary Islands)** for one volunteering project **in France**, within the framework of the European Solidarity Corps programme of the European Union.

Sending organisation: Cabildo de Gran Canaria (local public administration of Gran Canaria Island), Consejería de Educación y Juventud

Host organisation: Centre Régional Information Jeunesse Nouvelle-Aquitaine – Site de Limoges (Regional Youth Information Centre of Nouvelle-Aquitaine, office of Limoges). Association that supports young people by providing them practical information about their everyday life (accommodation, job, leisure, international mobility...).

• Objectives

- > Bringing a European dimension to the activities of the youth information centre,
- > Ensuring a better visibility of international mobility and European citizenship for young people.

• Activities

Sharing his/her mobility experience with young people from Limoges and Nouvelle-Aquitaine region,

- Informing young people about the opportunities of international mobility (studies, internships, volunteering, jobs, youth exchanges...),
- Participating in collective workshops about mobility, including with non-formal education methods,
- Receiving young people individually and support them in their mobility projects, especially for volunteering projects within the framework of the European Solidarity Corps (the centre has an accreditation to send French young people abroad): help in the search for projects, mobility preparation, support when they come back...,
- Helping to communicate about international mobility (posters, brochures, social medias, website, videos, testimonies...),
- > Participating in some projects with other local partners,
- Suggesting activities within the framework of mobility or about the European and international topics,
- > Participating in the activities of the office of Limoges, about youth information in general.

• Accommodation, food, transport and other arrangements

All the following practical arrangements are financed within the framework of the European Solidarity Corps programme :

- Accommodation (individual studio or shared flat with a private room, in the city centre of Limoges or next to it) found by the host organisation,
- ➤ Transport from the Canary Islands to Limoges, and from Limoges to the Canary Islands (360€ maximum),
- Local transport (bus card),
- An amount of money will be given each month to buy food,
- Health insurance (CIGNA)
- > Pocket money for personal costs (6€/day, that is to say around 180€/month),
- > At least online French lessons (thanks to OLS platform),
- On-arrival and mid-term trainings with other European volunteers doing their project in France, (in another French city),
- Mobility preparation (by the Canarian sending organisation),
- > The volunteer will be followed by the sending and host organisations.

• Volunteer profile

- > Age: 18-30 year-old volunteer,
- > Spanish residents or legally residing in Spain, and coming from the Canary Islands,
- > No special certification, diploma or professional experience is required,
- > Being proactive, spontaneous, open-minded and be ready to have challenges,
- > Being ready to live in a medium-sized city of around 135 000 inhabitants,
- > Having interests in the field of youth information and international mobility,
- Basic notions of French would be more convenient for the project (or will to learn and speak French during the mobility period).
